Topic: L.I.F.E. Scholarship

Applicants should:

1. Read the L.I.F.E. Scholarship requirements
2. Type or print all information on the two- page application. Do not send this page with application.
3. Read and meet the requirements (1-2) listed below.
4. Answer all questions and supply all supporting data. Failure to do so will restrict the application's review by scholarship committee.
5. Remember to sign your application.
6. Mail application materials under the same (one) cover to insure receipt of all your information. Special folders and presentations are not needed and are not viewed by the scholarship committee.

Each applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Applicant must be an active member in good standing of Texas 4-H, F.F.A. or FHA a verification letter from your FFA, FHA, and or CEA Agent is needed to participate.
2. Applicant must have competed actively in local fair competitive events.
3. Applicant must rank high scholastically preferably in the upper 33% of his or her class.
4. Applicant must furnish official transcript of his or her school record. The collage entrance test scores, size of class, and rank in the class should be entered in this transcript. Complete disclose information to students can place the transcript and or principal letter in separate sealed envelope.
5. Applicant must attach a recent photograph or clear snapshot on the proper place provided.
6. High School principal must furnish a statement regarding:
 - a). Applicant's general qualification
 - b) verification whether or not U.S. Citizen
7. Application must be a graduate from high school during the year of application, and begin college or University the following fall semester.
8. Applicant must attend an accredited College or University in Texas, and enroll for and pass a minimum of 12 hours per semester; Exceptions to the minimum hour requirement must be requested in writing to the LIFE Office.
9. Applicant preferred to major in an agricultural and or natural resource or consumer education related curriculum.
