- MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES
- NO GAITERS ARE ALLOWED; PLEASE GO TO THE LIFE OFFICE FOR A MASK
- BRACELETS ARE REQUIRED FOR DAILY ADMISSION TO THE LIFE FAIR GROUNDS
- SOCIAL DISTANCE IS REQUIRED
- NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS
- FOOD AND DRINKS ARE ONLY TO BE CONSUMED AT THE DESIGNATED AREAS
- SANITATION STATIONS ARE AVAILABLE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS AND VISITORS



COVID-19 TESTING REQUIREMENTS

- **MANDATORY** COVID-19 TESTING WILL BE DONE AT THE L.I.F.E. FAIR GROUNDS AT THE RED BARN (TAKE A RIGHT AS YOU ENTER LIFE GROUNDS)
- COVID-19 TESTING WILL DESIGNATED BY DATE AND TIME FOR EACH EXHIBITOR AND ONLY TWO ADULT GUESTS PER EXHIBITOR ARE ALLOWED
- SCHEDULE FOR COVID-19 TESTING WILL BE A DAY PRIOR TO THE EXHIBITORS SHOW DATE, TIME WILL BE SCHEDULED AND SENT TO EACH EXHIBITOR
- COVID-19 SCHEDULES MUST BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED AND WILL NOT BE CHANGED FOR ANY EXHIBITOR OR GUEST
- RAPID TESTS WILL BE SELF-ADMINISTERED AND STAND-BY ASSISTANCE OR GUIDANCE WILL BE AVAILABLE
- TEST RESULTS WILL BE READY IN 15 MINUTES AND EACH EXHIBITOR/GUEST WILL RECEIVE A COPY OF THEIR RESULTS
- IF RESULTS ARE NEGATIVE, THE EXHIBTOR WILL RECEIVE A COMPLIMENTARY BRACELET AND THEIR TWO GUESTS WILL BE ASKED TO REPORT TO THE TICKET TABLE TO PURCHASE SHOW DAY BRACELETS
- IF RESULTS ARE POSITIVE FROM ANY EXHIBITOR OR THEIR GUESTS, THE EXHIBITOR AND GUESTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER FAIR GROUNDS OR PERMITTED TO SHOW THEIR PROJECT (**L.I.F.E. COVID-19 TEST RESULTS ARE FINAL AND THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS**)
- AN ALTERNATE/SUBSTITUTE EXHIBITOR MAY BE DESIGNATED AND MUST HAVE TESTED NEGATIVE IN ORDER TO SHOW PROJECT
- **ANY EXHIBITOR AND THEIR GUESTS THAT HAVE TWO PROJECTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRES THE NIGHT BEFORE THEIR SECOND SHOW DATE IF THE PROJECT IS ON A DIFFERENT DATE** IF APPLICABLE**

New Rules for 2021 "Show & Go!"

These changes to the rules only apply to 2021 fair

- L.I.F.E. fair for 2021 will be a "Show and Go!"
- Exhibitor and guests must have a negative COVID test result in order to be allowed to participate. COVID testing will occur the night before every show on the Webb County Fairgrounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Everyone on the fairgrounds will be required to wear a mask (no gaiters) and social distancing will be followed. Including any State, County and City mandates.
- Each exhibitor will be allowed a maximum of 2 additional wristbands for parent/adult guest. Wristbands will be color coded per species and are \$10 per wristband (only Check or Credit Card will be accepted) Once a negative COVID test is confirmed the wristband will be placed on the wrist of the exhibitor and guests No additional bracelets may be purchased and lost bracelets will not be replaced.
- Any positive test result at time of testing on the Webb County Fairgrounds will cause the exhibitor and family and guests to be eliminated from respective show. A substitute exhibitor will be allowed only if all criteria is met.
- Substitute exhibitors will be allowed for COVID related issues and will be reviewed on case by case bases. Please contact Selina Rodriguez @ 956. 235.1998
- Substitute exhibitors may show more than 2 animals but will not qualify for showmanship as a substitute exhibitor.
- No children other than exhibitors will be allowed.
- Anyone attending "Show and Go!" more than one day will test on the first day and will need to complete COVID questionnaire on the other days. Questionnaire must be completed the night before the next show to receive bracelet for the following day.
- **On show day**, traffic to unload will come in through blue gate behind restaurant for swine, steers, goats, and lambs and blue gate at top of hill for rabbits and poultry. Once animals have been unloaded trailers must exit through gate behind pavilion and park in designated trailer parking in parking lot.
- All assigned pen, tie, and cage assignments will be assigned** Please note no changes will be made.
- Weigh and sift -Each species will have a scheduled time, please check for your time.

- **No animals will remain on fairgrounds** (only exception will be grand and reserve animals). Any livestock project that remains on the fairgrounds after 6:00pm or 1 hour after end of show will be considered abandoned and becomes property of L.I.F.E.
- No clipping or shearing will be permitted on fairgrounds.
- Show boxes will be allowed in with limited items and are subject to inspection.
- Blowers & trimming stands will be allowed.
- **Trim stalls, clippers, shearers will NOT be permitted.**
- NO tents allowed.
- Showmanship will be judged during the show by a different showmanship judge and announced at end of show.
- At the conclusion of each class, exhibitors placing 1st-10th will proceed to photo station to take their backdrop picture. These pictures will be used for auction purposes.
- The show will be non-terminal and exhibitors will be given the option to
 1. **Floor the animal.** Trailer will be available daily. (option not available for swine, rabbits, or poultry) For those that placed 1st-10th floor price will be credited to buyer and full sale amount given to exhibitor.

For those that did not place and floor the animal they will be given the floor amount.
 2. **Take livestock project home** – If places 1st-10th take their animal home. **Floor price will be subtracted from the sale amount.**
 3. **Donate to Sacred Heart-ONLY rabbits and poultry will be accepted.**
 4. **Exhibitor must decide by end of their class what they want to do with their project. A card will be given to them at sift & weigh to complete. That card will need to be given at table set up after each show.**
- Once the exhibitor has completed their class, livestock project has been addressed, and has taken picture. The exhibitor and their guests must exit fairgrounds. **No congregating will be permitted.**
- No Herds man ship competition. No decorations of any kind will be allowed.

Security will be on Webb County Fairgrounds Show week.



L.I.F.E. 2021 Rabbit Show

- CDC Guidelines and State, City and County mandates will be followed.
- Sift and weigh will be in scheduled in time increments by 4-H Club or F.F.A. Chapter
- One parent/guardian per exhibitor in the sift and weight assigned rabbit area.
- Follow 6ft. apart marked floor map and proceed to sift area.
- Place rabbit cage at registration table and proceed to assigned tape markings and wait for judge or L.I.F.E. Superintendent's directives.
- After every rabbit the scale will be disinfected.
- If rabbit clears the sift proceed to assigned cage by Rabbit Superintendent/L.I.F.E. Committee Member.
- If rabbit(s) are sifted exhibitor will be asked to exit the fairgrounds with their project unless they are along with the project.
- Once rabbit has been placed in assigned rabbit cage and set up. The exhibitor and parent/guardian will be asked to exit the rabbit area.
- Disinfecting Crew will be disinfecting area after each 4H- Club / F.F.A. Chapter increment is done with sift and weigh. Everyone will be asked to exit the rabbit area at a set time for the crew to proceed with disinfecting procedures.
- Prep area will be assigned and all CDC guidelines must be followed. **Ensure mask is worn at all times** (No gaiters allowed) and social distancing is followed.
- Exhibitors will be allowed to begin prepping their project 20-25 minutes before their class begins. Rabbit Superintendent/ LIFE Committee Member will direct exhibitors to limit congregation.

Only two exhibitors per show table in the pavilion at time of rabbit judging.

L.I.F.E. 2021 Poultry Show

- CDC Guidelines and State, City and County mandates will be followed.
- Weigh & sift will be in scheduled in time increments by 4-H Club and F.F.A. Chapters
- One parent/guardian per exhibitor in the weigh and sift area will be allowed.
- Exhibitors and parents/guardians must wear masks (NO gaiters allowed) during weigh and sift.
- Follow social distancing (6ft. apart) as marked on the floor map and proceed to sift area.
- Only exhibitors will remain with their poultry projects during weigh in and inspection by the judge, L.I.F.E. Superintendents will provide further instructions on how to proceed.
- If the poultry project qualifies for the show, the exhibitor will proceed to their assigned cage.
- Once your poultry project has been secured in their assigned cage, the exhibitor and parent/guardian must leave the poultry area.
- If your poultry project is sifted, exhibitor may choose to donate to Sacred Heart Children's Home or must exit fair grounds with their sifted project.
- Disinfecting will be done as need by the Superintendents.
- Exhibitors will be allowed to prepare their projects for the show approximately 15- 30 minutes before their show begins.
- Superintendents and Volunteers will ensure that all exhibitors are following social distancing and wearing MASKS.
- Exhibitor will be allowed to have one fellow exhibitor assist in show, if needed.

2021 L.I.F.E Auction

- Auction is scheduled on Saturday-March 6, 2021 @ 10:30a.m.
- Auction is closed to spectators, NO Parents/guardians allowed in Pavilion.
- Exhibitors will be given a different color bracelet to participate auction.
- Exhibitors will be given a scheduled time and holding area for Auction day.
- Auction will be livestreamed.
- Only Grand Champion and Reserve Champions livestock, rabbits and poultry will walk through Auction with Exhibitor
- Auction for places 1st-8th will occur without livestock, rabbit or poultry project. Exhibitor will walk in the auction ring and will be allowed to walk with a poster, which may include a picture of their livestock project and their award. **Posters cannot be larger than 24"x 36"
- **If exhibitor does not arrive by allotted time scheduled. They "may" forfeit their opportunity to walk through the auction and lose any potential auction earnings.**
